Notes:

Closing of school because of inclement weather or other emergencies normally shall be the decision of the Superintendent based upon the conditions that exist within the school district. When schools are closed as a result of the Governor declaring a state of emergency, those days normally will not have to be made up.

The adopted 2009-2010 school calendar provides for more than the minimum number of hours (1,060) prescribed by state law. Consequently, if schools must be closed due to emergencies, the lost hours of instruction may not have to be made up unless the number of instructional hours falls below 1,060. If that situation occurs, the lost time will be made up in a way (or ways) deemed to be most appropriate by the Superintendent.
